### **Montesano Has Open Parks Board Positions**

The Montesano Parks Board has two open positions to fill. The Montesano Parks Board meets on the first Wednesday of each month in the evening at 7:00 pm. The mission of the Parks Board is to develop and maintain a high quality, diversified parks and recreation system that preserves our existing opportunities, while creating new recreation and leisure time opportunities to support the growing needs of our community.

Parks Board members are appointed by the Mayor with Council confirmation. Candidates must have a Montesano address, an interest in the management and enhancement of the Montesano park facilities and recreation programs, and a lot of energy and commitment to serve. The position has no compensation. The term of appointment is for 3 years.

The Parks Board currently has no city staff assistance. Current Parks Board members include Alice Hutchinson, Brandon Klinger and Lori Benedict. Pat Herrington is the current City Council liaison to the Board. The Board has the responsibility to:

- 1) Make recommendations to the Council regarding parks, facilities, programs and budgets;
- 2) Develop rules for use and management of the parks and facilities; and
- 3) Coordinate and cooperate with user groups and other agencies such as the school district, County, and state.
